11. Students will not be permitted to begin a new school year until all fees/tuition have been paid in full from the previous year(s).
12. All fees must be paid in full upon withdrawal of a student.
13. All financial information is mailed to the address of the student's residence. It is the enrolling parent's/guardian's responsibility to share this information with other appropriate adults.
14. All financial obligations must be current in order to register for the next school year.
15. A monthly late fee of \$25.00 is charged to accounts with past-due tuition and/or fees after the 15th of any month.
16. The student's full financial commitment to the school is due to be paid in full by 15 May 2013 (tuition, instructional fees, registration fees, late fees).

Tuition Insurance is required for all payment options 1.b, 1.c, and 2. above. The cost of the Tuition Insurance is \$135.00 and is payable when this signed contract is presented to Bluegrass Christian School. Tuition Insurance protects both you and the school, in most situations, should you have to withdraw your student from the school. The Tuition Insurance cost is non-refundable. This program insures fees (prepaid and due) in the event of separation according to the terms of the policy. I have received and read the enclosed brochure detailing the terms and conditions of coverage concerning this Plan.

Financial Commitment

Enrollment in Bluegrass Christian School is for the entire Academic year; therefore, full tuition charges for the given school year are due in the event of voluntary withdrawal or involuntary withdrawal or involuntary dismissal of any student. Exceptions to this policy may be made when a withdrawal request is made in writing to BCS and **1) withdrawal occurs because the family moves more than thirty (30) miles from BCS and the student doesn't attend school in Richmond; 2) the death of a parent or guardian who is a member of the child's household or is providing significant financial support occurs; or 3) either parent or guardian becomes unemployed for more than sixty (60) days.** The parent's/guardian's signatures at the end of this Financial Commitment section are acknowledgment of the parent's/guardian's financial responsibility.

1. Whether you are a new enrollment or re-enrolling your child at BCS, please sign this contract with commitments and return them to BCS. Your financial commitment of **\$4500** annually may be paid several ways.
 - a. You can pay any balance in-full. With this option tuition insurance is optional. or
 - b. Make twelve (12) monthly payments of **\$375** due June 1 and ending on May 1 of the given school year. With this option you are also required to purchase tuition insurance. or
 - c. Make ten (10) equal payments of **\$450**, due the first of each month, beginning on **August 1** and ending on **May 1** of the given school year. With this option you are also required to purchase tuition insurance.

2. Students beginning school after the classes start will pay **\$450** per month for each month due the first of the month the student begins class until through 1 May of the given school year. You are required to purchase tuition insurance.

1. The **Instructional Fee** of **\$235** can be paid in several ways. If
 - A. you pay half your Instructional Fee (\$117.50) by 15 April 2012 and
 - B. pay your Instructional fee in full (\$235.00) by 1 June 2012 and
 - C. turn in a signed contract by 15 April 2012 you will maintain your 2011-2012 tuition cost.

If you do not meet A, B, and C above and your child returns they will have the new tuition rate. Students who start part way through the school year are required to pay the instructional fee when the student starts classes.

3. Student Accident Insurance is required for all students.
4. **A student will not be allowed to attend class if tuition/fees become 30 days past due.**
5. Book charges and special fees are due when posted to account unless notified otherwise.
6. **Registration fees/Instructional fees are nonrefundable and due at enrollment.**
7. Transcript/diploma, or other school information shall not be issued until all financial obligations are met in full.
8. Due to general expenses and staff commitments, no reduction can be made in tuition due to absenteeism.
9. Lunch fees and school age extended care are optional services; therefore, each service has a separate fee and is not included in the regular tuition.
10. A \$20.00 charge is made for returned checks.

Family Commitment

1. We as parent(s) or guardians(s) accept God's responsibility which says. "Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead bring them up in the knowledge and instruction of the Lord." (Eph. 6:4), and do affirm that this training is carried on in the home. We promise that the home will provide a secure haven of safety, free from harmful influences.
2. We have carefully examined and agree with the Mission Statement, Philosophy and Statement of Faith of Bluegrass Christian School as stated inside this application and desire BCS to work with us in the total education of our children.
3. We understand that students are accepted on a trial basis for the first grading period.
4. In full cooperation with BCS, we will regularly attend Parent-Teacher meetings and other functions requiring participation.
5. We pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of BCS and will direct any criticisms to the appropriate person as outlined in Matthew 18 and will deal with challenges by going directly to the person involved in the situation.
6. The teachers and administration are given full discretion in the discipline of students, within the discipline guidelines stated in the Parent/Student Handbook.
7. We agree to support the policies and procedures set forth in the parent/Student Handbook. It is understood that these policies apply to student behavior both on and off campus as long as he or she is enrolled as a student at BCS. We understand and accept the fact that the Administration and Board of Directors have the responsibility and freedom to determine when it is in the student's and/or school's best interest for a student to withdraw.
8. As parents or guardians, we agree to work closely with BCS in helping the students to learn and to solve their school related problems.
9. We understand that BCS is a non-profit ministry operating on the principle of faith. Tuition is kept as low as possible to make Christian education available to those who desire it for their children. Tuition and fees do not cover all operating costs. Additional funds and needs must be met with gifts from our parents, friends, grandparents, alumni, foundations and corporations. We ask that each parent purpose to give, as regularly as God provides, to meet the financial needs; to perform services and volunteer when needed; and to uphold BCS consistently in prayer.
10. Tuition rates and fees to be paid will be given to us and reviewed carefully. After enrollment, the Registration fee is NON-REFUNDABLE under any circumstances, and does not apply toward tuition.

We understand this to mean that this Family Commitment is also a binding financial obligation. Should a change during the year become necessary, tuition will be pro-rated on a monthly basis, if conditions for exception to the Financial Commitment are met. While tuition is pro-rated on a monthly basis for students entering or leaving during the year, all other (testing, application etc.) fees are payable in full when a student first enters school and are non-refundable.
